

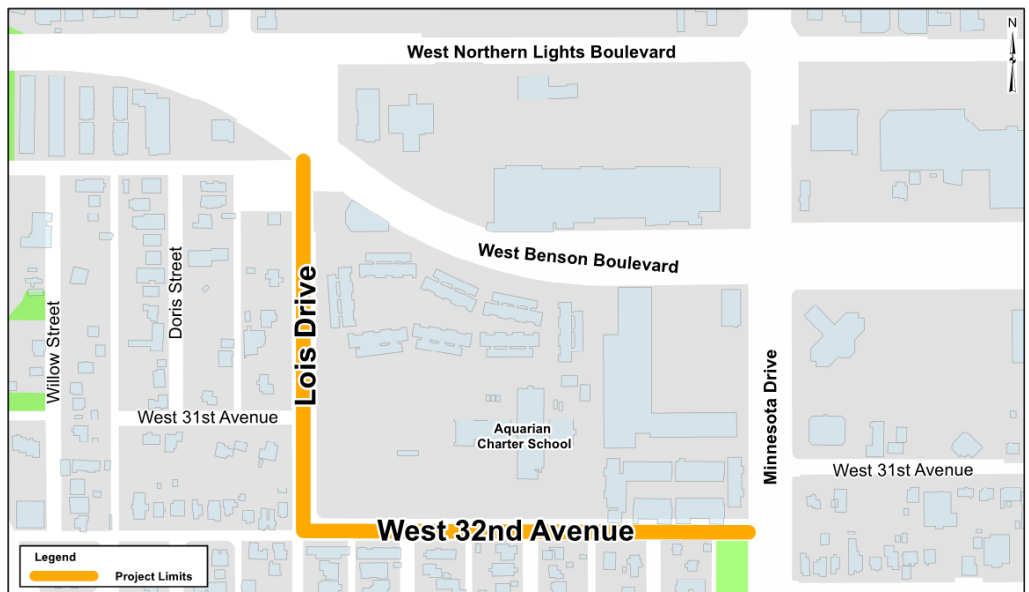

Project Scope and Background

This project will upgrade Lois Drive (from West 32nd Avenue to Benson Boulevard, see map below) and West 32nd Avenue (from Lois Drive to Minnesota Drive) to improve non-motorized connectivity by constructing a new roadway. Improvements may include: new road foundation, new asphalt pavement, new storm drain system, new non-motorized transportation facilities, and improved street lighting.

Lois Drive and W. 32nd Avenue are both strip-paved roads without curbs, gutters, or adequate drainage. These roads serve established residential neighborhoods, several businesses, and an elementary school but lack dedicated amenities for bicyclists and pedestrians. This project will improve the roadways to support non-motorized traffic. The Spenard Community Council has listed upgrades to Lois Drive as their highest priority capital project for 2019.
